

LTATV Industry Collaboration

28 February - 01 March Event Outcomes 2017

PEO-SOF Warrior hosted a two-day industry collaboration event on 28 February and 1 March. As part of the market research strategy for PM-FOSOV, the topic for this event was to explore hybrid, fuel cell and electric powertrain configurations for the Light Tactical All-Terrain Vehicle (LTATV). The objective was to determine the maturity of technologies and whether hosting a rodeo would be viable within the next fiscal year. A secondary objective was to help drive understanding of the capabilities and limitations of vehicles based on the technologies to aid in developing requirements for the next iteration of the LTATV.

- 7 companies attended and briefed silent LTATV technical solutions
- Vendors were able to familiarize themselves with the LTATV program through interaction with users, SME's and PM's
- Government participants from over 10 agencies attended due to interest in the capability
- Program Office obtained insightful and detailed feedback from government representatives
- Academia from MIT Lincoln Labs and the University of Pittsburgh attended
- Technologies briefed were more mature than anticipated
- Feasibility of hosting a rodeo was proven as a result of the briefings provided
- Based on increased awareness of technology the ability to define and refine user requirements has been improved
