



# Science and Technology Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) 20.1

20, 23-24 March 2020

Event Outcomes

Phase I of SBIR 20.1 involved a solicitation of contract proposals or grant applications to conduct feasibility-related experimental or theoretical R/R&D related to described agency requirements. The object of this phase was to determine the scientific and technical merit and feasibility of the proposed effort and the quality of performance of the SBC with a relatively small agency investment before consideration of further Federal support in Phase II.

Special Areas of Interest included:

- Phase I: SOCOM20-001 Platform Agnostic Data Storage Infrastructure
- Phase I: SOCOM20-003 Multi-FMV Fusion 3D Capability
- Direct to Phase II: SOCOM20-D002 Phase I Topic Human Geography 3D Street View
- Direct to Phase II: SOO Human Geography 3D Steet View

- All evaluations for the SOCOM 20.1 BAA were completed within 30 days of proposal receipt.
- The event allowed the evaluation team to select the best firms and improve evaluation quality.
- The SBIR evaluation team is on track to meet their goal for contract awards 90 days after proposal receipt.
