Event Outcomes

Phase I of SBIR 20.3 involved a solicitation of contract proposals or grant applications to conduct feasibility-related experimental or theoretical R/R&D related to described agency requirements. The object of this phase was to determine the scientific and technical merit and feasibility of the proposed effort and the quality of performance of the SBC with a relatively small agency investment before consideration of further Federal support in Phase II.

- Out of 48 submissions, USSOCOM selected 6 organizations to present their slide deck. Out of those 6 organizations, 3 were chosen to be awarded a Phase I SBIR for the topic area SOCOM 203-004, titled, "Geospatially Integrated Cyber Situational Awareness (Cyber COP)."
- All evaluations for the USSOCOM 20.3 BAA were completed within 30 days of proposal receipt.
- The SBIR evaluation team is on track to meet their goal for contract awards 90 days after proposal receipt.
