



Science and Technology Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) 21.1

SOFWERX, on behalf of USSOCOM, assisted in scheduling pitch days for two topic numbers for Phase I and Phase II SBIR 21.1 awards. This effort involved a solicitation of contract proposals or grant applications to conduct feasibility-related experimental or theoretical R/R&D related to described agency requirements. The objective of this phase was to determine the scientific and technical merit and feasibility of the proposed effort and the quality of performance of the SBC with a relatively small agency investment before consideration of further Federal support in Phase II.

Event Outcomes

- Out of 57 submissions for topic number S211-002, 6 capabilities were selected to present their slidedeck to Government evaluators. Out of those 6 capabilities, 3 were recommended for a Phase I SBIR award.
- Out of 14 submissions for topic number S211-D005, 7 capabilities were selected to present their slidedeck to Government evaluators. Out of those 7 capabilities, 3 were recommended for a Phase II SBIR award.
- All evaluations for the USSOCOM 21.1 BAA were completed within 30 days of proposal receipt.
- The SBIR evaluation team is on track to meet their goal for contract awards 90 days after proposal receipt.
