



Science and Technology Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) 21.3

8-9, 22 November 2021 Event Outcomes

SOFWERX, on behalf of USSOCOM, assisted in scheduling pitch days for two topic numbers for Phase I and Direct to Phase II SBIR 21.3 awards. This effort involved a solicitation of contract proposals or grant applications to conduct feasibility-related experimental or theoretical R/R&D related to described agency requirements. The objective of this phase was to determine the scientific and technical merit and feasibility of the proposed effort and the quality of performance of the SBC with a relatively small agency investment before consideration of further Federal support in Phase II.

- Phase I SBIRs: Out of 25 submissions for topic number S213-003, 5 capabilities were selected to participate in the virtual pitch day presentations for possible follow-on Phase I SBIR awards.
- Direct to Phase II SBIRs: Out of 7 submissions for topic number S213-D005, 3 capabilities were selected to participate in the virtual pitch day presentations for possible follow-on Phase II SBIR awards.
- The SBIR evaluation team is on track to meet their goal for contract awards 90 days after proposal receipt.
