



Phase II: Rapid Tactical Data Extraction SSE CCE

Event Outcomes

The SOFWERX Capability Collaboration Event conducted jointly by the Program Office Sensitive Site Exploitation (PM-SSE), Program Manager-Sensitive Site Exploitation (PM-SSE), followed by the Identity Intelligence Exploitation Center (I2EC) was an extremely successful one-day event that brought together several collaborative minds.

10 industry partners gathered to collaborate on producing unusual and cutting-edge technologies, focusing on future forensic scientific approaches to complex problem solving.

- Several partnerships were formed that may have utility in better addressing SSE requirements:
- Two companies partnered for a separate briefing (collaborating under a Non-Disclosure Agreement) where they indicated their tools could complement one another. A CRADA for one company has been initiated.
- One industry partner is teaming with two other participating companies. Their proposed technology would be designed at the EAC level for now where analytics could be performed before being pushed up for further exploitation.
- One participating company may require additional consideration from the SSE-PMO due to the need of a dedicated server to power the technology.
- The PM-SSE and the I2EC agreed that follow on conversations on a one-on-one basis would be conducted with each partnered team to discuss future requirements, capabilities and a method for moving forward.
